One was a young deaf girl that Debbie and I have had a special burden for. What a blessing when the Lord answers prayer!

I preached a meeting at the Rui Baptist Church not long ago. One night before the preaching service began, a young man named Nelson (age 18-19) gave his testimony how Christ changed his life. He said that before he came to Christ, he was deep into sin; all his time was filled with smoking, drugs, stealing, and gambling. He said that everybody called him by his nickname "Fifty-Two". I asked those that sat by me why they called him "Fifty-Two". Nobody knew. Later when I asked him why they called him that, he said it was because he was always gambling playing cards. I asked if I could give him a new number. He smiled and said he would like that very much. I thought of John 1:12. Now he is known as "One-Twelve"! Now when people ask him why they call him "One-Twelve", he has an open door to witness for Christ!

The Churches are all doing well. We have purchased an additional piece of ground at the Rui church. The church building needs to be moved onto the new ground because of flooding.
